	In response to this item being raised by AH, LS explained that the EFL has merely gone out with an RFP (request for proposal) for their (our) content and broadcasting rights beyond June 2024.	
	As part of this, they have not stipulated one way or the other concerning streaming or blocked hours. It is expected a range of partners will bid for the rights, but how they propose to use our content is not yet known. We will continue to keep the SB and fans generally updated as this matter progresses.	
	LS also noted that we would be streaming games during the World Cup, as Article 48 does not apply unless there are 12+ games across the top two divisions on that given day.
